Linux in GeoSciences

- 100+ Linux clients
- Dozens of rack-mounted servers
- Previously (nearly) all “managed” by *gits-config*

What is *gits-config*?

- A bunch of scripts, mainly bash and perl
- Very small initial learning curve
- Minimal boiler-plate
- Keep it simple...

What's wrong with *gits-config*

- Many assumptions about initial state
- Relies on blunt upstream tools
- Requires development time

The promise of LCFG

- Well understood frame-work
- Others solving the same problems
- Few assumptions about initial state
- We already know what we want configured
